- 1. Please enter all information in the booking form. To confirm your reservation, a deposit of 30% of the tour fee is required. If the departure date of the tour is within 30 days, the full amount of the tour fee should be paid.
- 2. Passport must be valid for a minimum of 6 months from the day of arrival at your destination. Please note: Participation in the Brown line and Orange Line(Summer:March September) requires holding a Schengen multiple-entry visa.
- 3. Agents are not authorized to sell tours for less or more than official price listed. GOEUGO Does not accept liability for any complaints concerning price discrepancies.
- 4. Please read the terms & conditions to understand what is and is not included in the price.

For participants who prefer single occupation (no sharing), this can be arranged by paying a single supplement fee of € 60 per person/night. This preference must indicated at time of booking, and with a minimum of 7 days prior to joining the tour. Once the booking is confirmed, it will not be possible to amend the room choice while on tour.

- 1. Each participant is allowed to bring one luggage on board (weight below 30kg, the sum of length, width and depth must not exceed 158cm). If passenger brings more than one subject to space available to charge each additional piece of luggage at €5/ day. Availability to accommodate cannot be guaranteed.
- 2. Most attractions points in Europe cannot be reached directly by coaches, and will require participants to travel on foot. If the participants are of limited mobility, this tour may not be suitable for you. We cannot offer compensation or refunds for missed attractions, so please think twice before joining the tour. Once the booking is completed, it also means accepting the terms and conditions set by the tour operator.
- 3. Tour managers and drivers are your hosts during the tour. They will help you explore and make the most of your time. Their passion for travel and local knowledge will enrich your holiday experience. Gratuity is paid directly to the tour manager and driver. We have set a obligatory tip of € 10 / £ 10 per passenger per day during your tour. Please prepare cash as a token of your appreciation.
- 4. Present your Booking Voucher to the tour manager when you board the coach. GOEUGO cannot allow delays by a single passenger or group. A participant's negligence and late arrival can result in missed connections for other passengers. In case of emergencies, please call our emergency numbers as printed on your Booking Voucher.
- 5. Participants are responsible to ensure that they are in possession of all necessary travel and health documents before departure. Further the participant must ensure that he/she (all members of their party) comply with required Visa, Passport or other travel documentation for the countries to visit. GOEUGO will not be liable if customers fail this responsibility and are refused entry, or delay the rest of the tour group. Any financial losses due to the failure of carrying the correct travel documents are at one's own expense.
- 6. Please avoid bringing valuables and precious jewelry. This includes passport and money. The tour company, driver and the tour manager will not be responsible for any losses incurred.
- 7. It is forbidden to bring contraband or other prohibited goods by law of each country that you are visiting. PRECAUTIONS FOR TRANSFERS SERVICES

- 1. The airport transfer service is a group pick-up and drop-off service. The driver is only responsible for the transfer from the airport to the group hotel and does not have any information regarding the goEUgo tour and tour group.
- 2. Clients who have booked the airport transfer service should confirm that their name and telephone number are correct and up to date prior their departure. Please make sure clients' mobile phone and mobile phone subscription can receive calls in Europe by enabling mobile phone roaming!
- 3. After arrival at the destination airport, it will take clients at least 30 45 minutes to pick up their luggage and go through border control. The transfer driver will wait for the clients at the airport 30 minutes after the arrival time of the clients at the airport.
- 4. The waiting time at the airport of the driver for the client for the transfer service is maximum 90 minutes after the arrival time of the flight, in case the waiting time is exceeded the driver may leave and is not liable for doing so. In the occurrence the driver needs to return to the airport to pick up the clients after the 90 minutes waiting time, a new service charge is applicable. If the flight is delayed by the airline and the transfer driver is not notified in a timely matter the transfer fee is non-refundable. Clients can try to claim compensation of the transfer fee from the airline themselves.
- 5. Regardless whether clients need to pick up checked baggage or not, they should go to the correct flight baggage conveyor belt number in order use the correct exit of the arrival hall and not take a random exit. The driver shall be waiting at the arrival hall exit of the designated flight with a name board of the registered client. If the clients are unable to find the driver with the correct name board there is no need to panic. Client should remain in the area and call the emergency number +31-643 448 738 for inquiries.
- 6. If the clients know their flight is delayed, changed, or cancelled clients should send a SMS and/or call the emergency number +31-643 448 738 to amend the transfer arrangement. Our operations team will do its best effort to reschedule the transfer however there will no guarantee the transfer arrangement can be changed. The transfer fee is non-refundable whether the transfer arrangement can be amended or not. Client can try to claim compensation from the airline for the transfer fee themselves. If clients need assistance upon arrival, they can call our team on the emergency number.
- 7. The transfer service from group hotel to the airport is arranged four hours prior to the scheduled flight departure time. If the clients experience any delay to its departure airport such as traffic jams, accidents, and other unforeseen events our team will do its best efforts

- to solve the situation. However, if clients are unable to make their flights due to a force majeure as mentioned above goEUgo company will not liable under any circumstances.
- 8. The allowed number of baggage pieces per client is two pieces (one cabin baggage piece and one check-in baggage piece). Any other baggage pieces exceeding this number is subject to a surcharge fee of 20 Euro per extra piece of baggage.

PRECAUTIONS FOR PRE- AND POST- TOUR ACCOMMODATION

- 1. Clients who have booked a pre-tour accommodation they can check in at the hotel's reception using the booking under the name of 【goEUgo Limited】, please provide the hotel reception the issued hotel voucher. A passport is required for hotel check-in. If clients have ordered a transfer from goEUgo the driver will transfer clients to group hotel.
- 2. Please note that international and European hotels have a check-in time of 3:00 pm. If clients arrive prior to the check-in time of the hotel and the room is not yet available they can rest in the hotel lobby first or clients can leave their luggage at the reception (if possible) and spend some time outside and return to check-in at 3:00 pm. Thank you for your understanding!
- 3. The temperature difference between day and night in Europe can be large and the annual average temperature exceeding 30 degrees Celsius is at most two months. Please note, European countries have a strong awareness of environmental protection, therefore some hotels in Europe are not equipped with air-conditioning. This lack of air-conditioning does not mean the hotel facilities are not up to standard. Thank you for your understanding.
- 4. Our tour guide will arrive with the group at the hotel usually between 8:00 9:00 pm on the day clients check-in for their pre-tour accommodation. The tour guide will contact clients at the hotel to inform them about next day departure time of the tour group. In case the tour guide is not able to contact the self-checked-in clients, the guide will leave a note for the clients at their hotel room door. Usually breakfast next day is at 7:00 am, if clients go to attend breakfast, they will be able to meet the tour guide and the other group members.
- 5. Clients who have booked a post-tour accommodation will not need to worry. The tour guide will send the clients directly to the hotel where they will stay after ending their tour. If clients also booked a transfer from the hotel to the airport the tour guide will provide the time and details of the transfer service.

GUARANTEED DEPARTURES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR (Weekly)

[Monday] Frankfurt → Bonn → Cologne → Amsterdam (500 km)

The morning begins with a leisurely drive north-west from Frankfurt to Bonn, the capital of the former West Germany until reunification. The national government is now in Berlin, but Bonn retains a rich history that is well worth exploring. Discover the city's secrets on an orientation stroll through its streets, walking past highlights such as the Rococofronted town hall and Ludwig Van Beethoven Haus, a museum celebrating the life of the much-loved composer. Then it's on to Cologne, where you'll head inside the city's glorious Gothic Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The rest of the afternoon is yours to explore Cologne further, to do a spot of local shopping or to simply relax with a suitably refreshing German brew. After lunch the day is rounded off with a drive into the Netherlands.

Overnight stay in Amsterdam or city nearby.

[Tuesday] Amsterdam → Zaanse Schans → Amsterdam (50 km)

A day of delights begins with a leisurely trip through the Dutch countryside, where you'll get to sample at close quarters some of the things that the Netherlands is traditionally famous for: clogs, cheese and windmills. Call in at the hugely popular model town of **Zaanse Schans**. Next, you'll head from the quiet countryside to the cosmopolitan city as your journey takes you back to Amsterdam. After visiting a well-known **diamond factory**, where you'll see the unique cutting techniques that have been practised here since the 16th century, you can take an optional hour-long pre-dinner canal cruise, which is a great way to discover more about this unique European city. After disembarking you'll walk to one of the city's grandest areas, **Dam Square**, where the Royal Palace is located and the King's birthday celebration takes place. You'll have photo opportunities here, free time for shopping or further sightseeing, and then round the day off with dinner. Overnight stay in Amsterdam or city nearby

From mid-March to mid-May the tour will also visit Keukenhof Garden, a 32-hectare seasonal exhibition of beautifully coloured and scented displays of spring flowers - most notably millions of tulips. More information please see: www.keukenhof.com

[Wednesday] Amsterdam → Brussels → Paris (500 km)

After leaving Amsterdam in the morning you'll head south across the border into Brussels, the Belgian capital and political centre of the European Union. On the way, the tour stops to see the distinctive *Atomium monument*, a cell-shaped structure of stainless-steel spheres and tubes built for the 1958 World's Fair. In the centre of Brussels itself an orientation tour will call in at the exquisite **Grand Place**, as well as seeing the famous impish *Manneken Pis Statue*. After some free time, you can try some mouth-watering Belgian delights. Then from Brussels we will head south again across the French border and on to the bright lights of Paris. *Overnight stay in Paris or city nearby*

[Thursday] Paris → Versailles → Paris (60 km)

Paris is your oyster over the next two days as you enjoy guided tours around one of the world's most celebrated cities. Your Parisian adventures get off to a spectacular start with a drive along the famous *Champs Élysées* to the *Place de la Concorde*, which played such a key part in the French Revolution. You'll also get to see the iconic *Arc de Triomphe* here too, the imposing monument that sits near the western end of the avenue and commemorates the fallen of the revolution and Napoleonic wars. You'll take in another significant historical building next as you head to *L'Hôtel National des Invalides*, where Napoleon's tomb is located, followed by a stop at the most legendary of all Paris's icons: *the Eiffel Tower*. Finally, you'll travel on the coach out through the Parisian suburbs to the splendid *Palace of Versailles*, the vast regal château that was the residence of the royal family until the start of the revolution in 1789. Today the palace is another popular Parisian attraction. In the evening, you can enjoy one of our optional Paris evening shows.

[Friday] Paris

In the morning, depart for the pier and take a sightseeing boat cruise on the Seine River at your own expense your, a great sightseeing option that offers splendid views of iconic Parisian landmarks, including Notre-Dame Cathedral and Pont Alexandre III. After a lunch, we visit to the Louvre, one of the world's greatest art museums. Here you'll set your eyes upon some of history's most famous masterpieces, including the Venus de Milo, Winged Victory of Samothrace (also called Nike of Samothrace), and Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa. Opt for a guided gallery tour, which will enhance your experience and allow you to browse through hundreds of works in just a few hours. Afterwards, you have an option of having a French 4 course dinner and show experience or spend time shopping at the legendary department stores Galeries Lafayette.

[Saturday] Paris → Reims → Luxembourg (420 km)

The Red Line tour leaves from Paris for a delightful scenic journey through the rolling countryside of the Champagne region, famous the world over for the sparkling white wine produced here. Enjoy seeing the historic attractions of provincial capital Reims, including the *city's cathedral* – a key national heritage site, where coronations of French kings took place from the 11th century onwards. History and tradition are equally evident in your next location: Luxembourg, the world's only remaining Grand Duchy. After arriving in refined Luxembourg city, you'll be introduced on foot to the main places of interest, including the *Place de Constitution* and *Pont Adolphe*, before having time for further exploration on your own.

Overnight stay in Luxembourg or city nearby

[Sunday] Luxembourg → Trier → Koblenz → Rudesheim am Rhein → Frankfurt (400 km)

Today we leave Luxembourg behind and head across another European border into Germany. The first stop is historic Trier, Germany's oldest city and the birthplace of Karl Marx. You'll have the chance to see from the outside the house where the influential philosopher was born, which now functions as the *Karl Marx Haus museum*. Your walking tour then takes you into the centre of Trier; here you can look around the city's impressive cathedral, where the celebrated Holy Robe – said to be the tunic of Christ – is preserved and occasionally displayed. Trier is also known as 'The Second Rome' (Constantine served as an administrator here for 10 years), and significant legacies of the once-great empire remain today. The highlight is undoubtedly *Porta Nigra*, the best-preserved Roman city gate north of the Alps, which you'll get to see and photograph. After an exciting morning in Trier, you'll drive on to Koblenz, famous as the location of the confluence of the Rhine and Mosel rivers. Here you have the option of indulging in a relaxing lunch alongside the water, then afterwards you can also choose to add on a scenic Rhine boat cruise for some memorable city vistas. Back on dry land you'll drive through the wine-making town of *Rüdesheim* (depending on road and traffic conditions). Then it is on to Frankfurt am Main, where you'll discover the delights of *Römerberg*, a charming plaza with a distinctive medieval town hall as its centrepiece

After boarding the luxury coach in Frankfurt, sit back and enjoy a scenic ride through some classic German countryside en route to the Czech Republic. Prague, one of Europe's most ornate cities, is your first destination. You will arrive in the evening, ready to discover this charming capital city with its fairy-tale architecture, the following morning.

Overnight stay in Prague or city nearby

[Tuesday] Prague → Bratislava (330 km)

Your Prague adventure begins with a spectacular walk along *the Royal Route*, following the traditional coronation path of the kings and queens of old Bohemia. You'll start from the top of *Castle Hill* in the Hradcany district, famous for its views over the red-roofed old city, and then tour *Prague Castle*. The castle has been the historic seat of Bohemia royalty since the 9th century, as well as home to the nation's presidents in recent times. Your exploration then heads off around the imposing gothic *St. Vitus Cathedral*, *the Old Royal Palace, St. George's Basilica* and along *Golden Lane*, an ancient thoroughfare lined with some wonderful traditional buildings. Later you will stroll across the iconic *Charles Bridge*, which arches gracefully over the *Vitava*, and on through the winding alleys to the *Old Town Square*, where you can see the *City Hall* and one of Prague's most well-known sights, *the Astronomical Clock*. After lunch in the square, you'll make the scenic transfer from Prague to the hotel in or near the Slovakian capital, Bratislava.

Overnight stay in Bratislava or city nearby)

[Wednesday] Bratislava → Budapest (200 km)

On Wednesday morning you will arrive in Hungary, the fourth country of the tour. From Vienna it's on to another Austrian gem, Mondsee. Mondsee is a town located on the shore of the *Lake Mondsee*. The town is home to the historic medieval *Mondsee Abbey*. The cloister church was used for the site of the wedding in The Sound of Music. After lunch you will continue to cross the German border to Munich. After arriving in Munich, you'll visit the *Marienplatz* and the *New Town Hall*. Marienplatz is a central square in the city centre of Munich since 1158. The New Town Hall is at the northern part of Marienplatz. It hosts the city government including the city council, offices of the mayors and part of the administration since 1874. Or you can enjoy a German beer in one of the beergardens before going to the hotel.

[Saturday] Madrid → Zaragoza (320 km)

The Yellow Line tour starts from the capital of Spain, Madrid, where you will pass by *the Cibeles Fountain*, and then arrive and visit *Plaza Mayor, Piazza di Spagna*, and *Royal Palace of Madrid*. The Royal Palace of Madrid was built by the Spanish Royal Family, showing the magnificent and splendid former empire and its historical grandeur. Then you'll arrive at the *Puerta del Sol*, a public square in Madrid. You can find the Km 0 square tile on the pavement, which represents the Puerta del Sol, the centre of the radial network of Spanish roads. Overnight stay in Zaragoza or city nearby

[Sunday] Zaragoza → Barcelona (300 km)

In the morning, you will drive directly to the Spanish warm and charming coastal city of Barcelona. After arrival you will visit the *Columbus Monument* and *Las Ramblas*, followed by the *Sagrada Família*, which is a large Roman Catholic Church in Barcelona, designed by Spanish architect Antoni Gaudí. Gaudí's unique, colourful, fairy tale decorations can be seen throughout the city and makes the place feel like a fantasy of the artist's mind. It's commercially and culturally rich, with Moorish and Arab culture and food. Although today's Valencia is less prominent, it's still an important city for large commerce exhibitions and trade fairs to be held in throughout the year. Upon arrival, you will visit the *Modernisme Plaza* of the City Hall of Valencia, *Valencia's Ancient City Gates* and the *Valencia Cathedral*, where the true Holy Grail is preserved, a photo stop at Ciudad de las Artes y las Ciencias. You will have a picture moment in front of **the Alhambra**, a Moorish citadel and palace, also known as the **Red Palace**. Following that, embark on a drive to the Mijas, a self-paid group activity, to visit famous white village and winding streets, charming nooks and crannies, flowerdecked house and numerous tiny squares. Then you will continue to tour the **old city of Granada**, with its exquisite and delicate architecture.

[Wednesday] Granada → Ronda → Seville (312km)

In the morning, Embark on a self-paid group activity in the morning and head to Ronda, the birthplace of Spanish bullfighters. Ronda proudly holds the distinction of being home to Spain's oldest bullring, where the love, hatred, and passion of the fighters of that era were witnessed. Despite its seemingly serene facade, Ronda emanates a vibrant Spanish charm that is unmatched. The town's romantic and peaceful white houses perched on the dramatic cliffs serve as a testament to its allure. Then tour will go northbound to the largest city of the autonomous region of Andalusia, Seville. This city was the capital of the Muslim dynasty, considered to be the guardian angel of culture in Andalusia and the birthplace of the flamenco dance. Seville is the primary setting of many operas, of which the best known is Bizet's Carmen. As the fourth largest city in Spain, it has hosted the Universal Exposition of Seville in 1992. Upon arrival, you will visit the Seville Cathedral, the largest Gothic cathedral and the third-largest church in the world. Its completion dates back to the early 16th century and now the cathedral halls serve as the Royal Chapel, the burial place of the kings for over a century. The tomb of Christopher Columbus, who discovered the New World, is also in the church as a credit to the great navigator. From there onwards you will see the Alcázar of Seville, which used to be a Muslim palace and a Spanish Royal Palace. The upper levels of the Alcázar are still used by the royal family as the official Seville residence today, which makes it the oldest royal palace still in use in Europe. It was registered in 1987 by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site, along with the Seville Cathedral. We will walk to Santa Cruz, Torre del Oro (the Tower of Gold) and Maria Luisa Park, where the 1992 World Expo was located. In Plaza de España (Spain Square), you can admire crafted porcelain paintings, detailing the history and elegance of historical Spain. Overnight stay in Seville or city nearby

[Thursday] Seville → Lisbon (460 km)

Today the tour departs for the capital and the largest city of Portugal, Lisbon. You are expected to arrive in *Cabo da Roca* (Cape Roca) in the afternoon. This is the most western extent of mainland Portugal and continental Europe. At the cape, you can see the enormous Atlantic Ocean surrounded by endless scenery. Don't forget to buy the remembrance certificate to prove that you once set foot on the west point. Later we will head back to the Lisbon city centre and visit the *Belém Tower* and *Jerónimos Monastery*, both were classified a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Belem Tower was important during the Age of Discovery, as this was the place where the ships would depart. The Jerónimos Monastery is one of the most prominent examples of Portuguese Late Gothic Manueline style of architecture in Lisbon. You will pass through the *Marquis of Pombal Square* and then stop at the *Rossio Square* for some free time. Those who are interested in Portuguese custard tarts can taste the authentic ones at a century-old bakery.

[Friday] Lisbon → Toledo → Madrid (675 km)

Today we will drive back to Madrid via *Toledo*, a World Heritage Site declared by UNESCO in 1986 for its extensive cultural and monumental heritage. This old city is located on a mountaintop, surrounded on three sides by a bend in the Tagus River, and contains many historical buildings. By strolling across the city, overlooking the *Alcázar of Toledo* and visiting the grand structure of the *Toledo Cathedral*, you will feel the bustling of Spain in the old time. Then take a well-earned rest as you sit back, drive through the breath-taking landscape of Spain and enjoy its rich palette of colours in natural surroundings, while you journey to Madrid.

Overnight stay in Jönköping or city nearby

[Monday] Jönköping → Stockholm (320 km)

After breakfast, you continue your way to the capital of Sweden, Stockholm. Built on 14 islands in the Baltic Sea, this city is crowned the most beautiful of all Nordic cities. After lunch, we embark on a city tour that includes the *City Hall of Stockholm (Stadshuset)*, one of the most beautiful and well-known buildings in the world with inside the most exclusive ballroom in Stockholm, the venue of the yearly *Nobel Banquet*. The national government is now in Berlin, but Bonn retains a rich history that is well worth exploring. Discover the city's secrets on an orientation stroll through its streets, walking past highlights such as the Rococofronted town hall and Ludwig Van Beethoven Haus, a museum celebrating the life of the much-loved composer. Then it's on to Cologne, where you'll head inside the city's glorious Gothic Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The rest of the afternoon is yours to explore Cologne further, to do a spot of local shopping or to simply relax with a suitably refreshing German brew. After lunch the day is rounded off with a drive into the Netherlands.

Overnight stay in Amsterdam or city nearby.

[Tuesday] Amsterdam → Zaanse Schans → Amsterdam (50 km)

A day of delights begins with a leisurely trip through the Dutch countryside, where you'll get to sample at close quarters some of the things that the Netherlands is traditionally famous for: clogs, cheese and windmills. Call in at the hugely popular model town of **Zaanse Schans**. Next, you'll head from the quiet countryside to the cosmopolitan city as your journey takes you back to Amsterdam. After visiting a well-known **diamond factory**, where you'll see the unique cutting techniques that have been practised here since the 16th century, you can take an optional hour-long pre-dinner canal cruise, which is a great way to discover more about this unique European city. After disembarking you'll walk to one of the city's grandest areas, **Dam Square**, where the Royal Palace is located and the King's birthday celebration takes place. You'll have photo opportunities here, free time for shopping or further sightseeing, and then round the day off with dinner. Overnight stay in Amsterdam or city nearby

From mid-March to mid-May the tour will also visit Keukenhof Garden, a 32-hectare seasonal exhibition of beautifully coloured and scented displays of spring flowers - most notably millions of tulips. More information please see: www.keukenhof.com

[Wednesday] Amsterdam → Brussels → Rouen (555 km)

. In the morning, depart for the capital of Belgium, Brussels. Start by visiting the Atomium, then explore the Gothic-style City Hall, Grand Place, and the famous Manneken Pis statue in the city center. In the afternoon, drive to France and continue towards the capital of the Normandy region, Rouen. Rouen is known for its rich culinary culture and is also a place of great reverence for the French saint, Joan of Arc, often referred to as the "Maid of Orleans." After arriving, enjoy dinner and return to the hotel for overnight accommodation. *Overnight stay in Rouen or city nearby* (Attention: During the Olympic Games in Paris from June to September 2024, the Wednesday itinerary for the Red Line tour is modified as mentioned above. [Thursday] Rouen → Mont Saint Michel → Rouen (500 km)

Mont Saint-Michel; It stands on the sea level, like a mystical island in the sea, often surrounded by vast stretches of sand that only become an island at low tide. When the tide rises, the water rushes in, turning the surroundings into a vast expanse. From a distance, the pyramid-shaped silhouette of Mont Saint-Michel emerges on the endless sea of sand, like a mirage, both enchanting and dreamlike. Mont Saint-Michel is the third most sacred site in Catholicism, after Jerusalem and the Vatican. In 1979, it was included in the UNESCO World Heritage List.

Overnight stay in Rouen or city nearby (Attention: During the Olympic Games in Paris from June to September 2024, the Thursday itinerary for the Red Line tour is modified as mentioned above. Additionally, there will be no Paris shuttle service provided, and accommodation before or after the tour will not be included.)

[Friday] Rouen → Paris → Chateau Theirry (240 km)

Visit famous attractions in Paris, such as the majestic and symbolic Arc de Triomphe, the bustling and lively Champs-Élysées, the Place de la Concorde, which was once the site of the guillotine during the French Revolution, Napoleon's Tomb and the Invalides, and pass by the centuries-old Notre-Dame Cathedral and the iconic Eiffel Tower towering on the banks of the Seine River. After lunch, head to the quay and take an optional sightseeing cruise along the Seine River, enjoying the beautiful scenery on both sides. It is a must-do activity when exploring Paris. Depart from Paris in the evening and proceed to the hotel for overnight accommodation. *Overnight stay in Chateau Thierry or city nearby* (Attention: During the Olympic Games in Paris from June to September 2024, the Friday itinerary for the Red Line tour is modified as mentioned above. Additionally, there will be no Paris shuttle service provided, and accommodation before or after the tour will not be included.)

[Saturday] Chateau Thierry → Reims → Luxembourg (292 km)

The Red Line tour leaves from Paris for a delightful scenic journey through the rolling countryside of the Champagne region, famous the world over for the sparkling white wine produced here. Enjoy seeing the historic attractions of provincial capital Reims, including the *city's cathedral* – a key national heritage site, where coronations of French kings took place from the 11th century onwards. History and tradition are equally evident in your next location: Luxembourg, the world's only remaining Grand Duchy. After arriving in refined Luxembourg city, you'll be introduced on foot to the main places of interest, including the *Place de Constitution* and *Pont Adolphe*, before having time for further exploration on your own.

Overnight stay in Luxembourg or city nearby

[Sunday] Luxembourg → Trier → Koblenz → Rudesheim am Rhein → Frankfurt (400 km)

Today we leave Luxembourg behind and head across another European border into Germany. The first stop is historic Trier, Germany's oldest city and the birthplace of Karl Marx. You'll have the chance to see from the outside the house where the influential philosopher was born, which now functions as the *Karl Marx Haus museum*. Your walking tour then takes you into the centre of Trier; here you can look around the city's impressive cathedral, where the celebrated Holy Robe – said to be the tunic of Christ – is preserved and occasionally displayed. Trier is also known as 'The Second Rome' (Constantine served as an administrator here for 10 years), and significant legacies of the once-great empire remain today. The highlight is undoubtedly *Porta Nigra*, the best-preserved Roman city gate north of the Alps, which you'll get to see and photograph. After an exciting morning in Trier, you'll drive on to Koblenz, famous as the location of the confluence of the *Rhine and Mosel rivers*. Here you have the option of indulging in a relaxing lunch alongside the water, then afterwards you can also choose to add on a scenic Rhine boat cruise for some memorable city vistas. Back on dry land you'll drive through the wine-making town of *Rüdesheim* (depending on road and traffic conditions). Then it is on to Frankfurt am Main, where you'll discover the delights of *Römerberg*, a charming plaza with a distinctive medieval town hall as its centrepiece
